Brian's early career included playing guitar and bass in various bands. One of the bands, 'Winters Tale' appeared on ITV's very popular show of the time, 'New Faces' and following their appearance had some success appearing several times on another TV show of the time, 'Summer Time Special'. The band was based in Oxford UK but toured the country, performing on the Mecca / Top Rank and college circuits, they worked extensively in major London hotels with many well known celebrities of the time and enjoyed some good summer seasons in the South West.

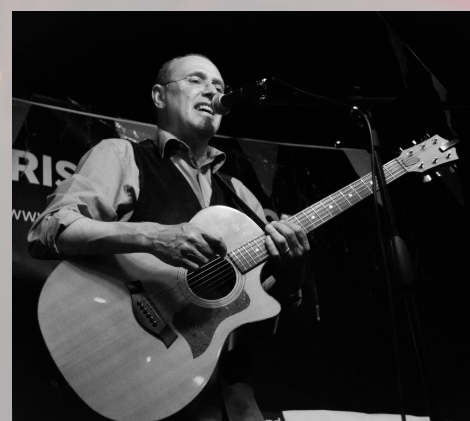
